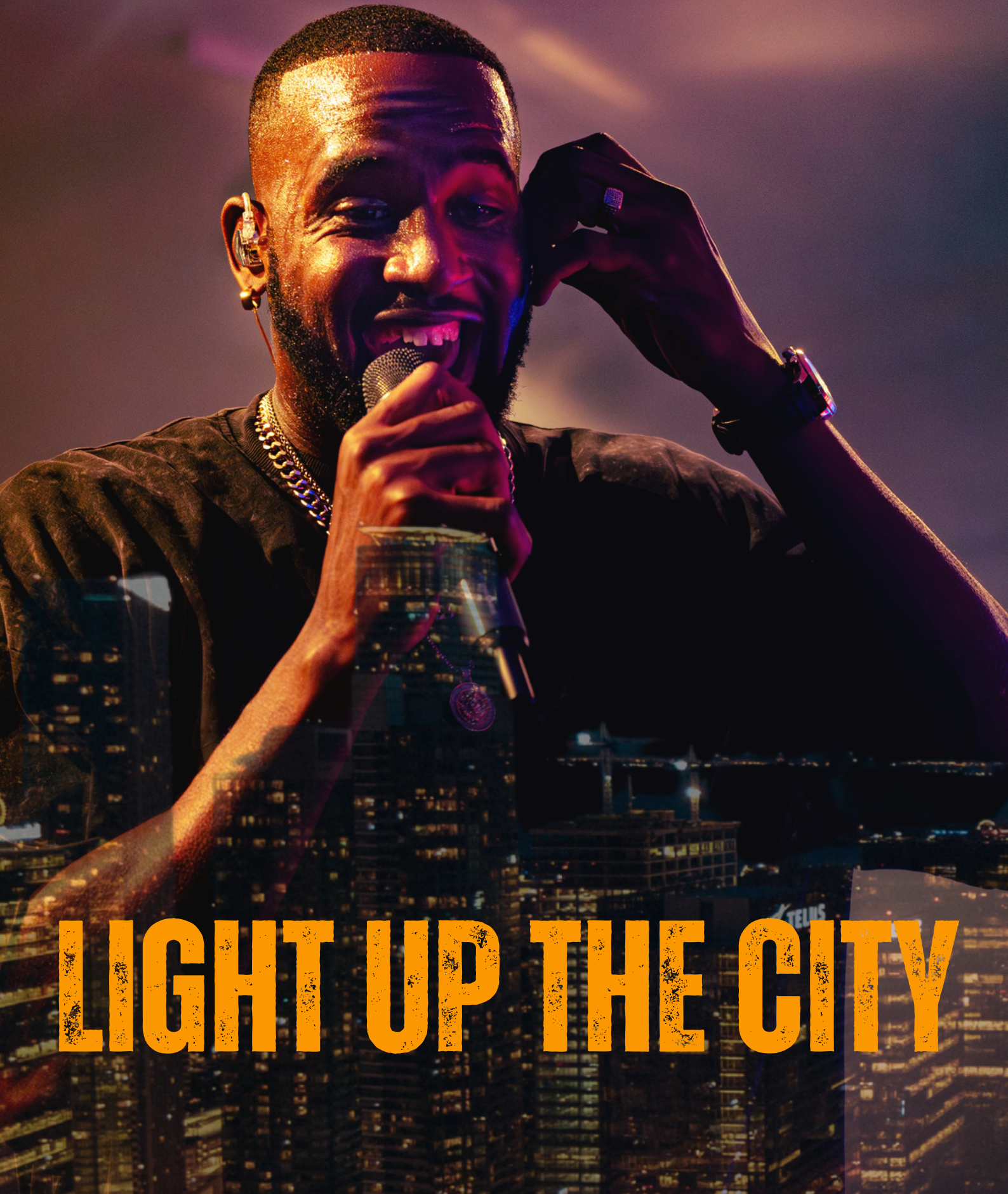

ABOUT OUR BASKETBALL CLINIC

As part of the Light Up The City experience, we are using sports as a powerful bridge to reach the younger generation. We will host a one-day, 2-3 hour basketball clinic led by 10-year professional basketball player Anthony Lee. This high-energy, intensive session is designed to sharpen fundamental skills, strengthen player development, and introduce key team concepts that elevate performance on the court. More than just skill training, this clinic is about building the whole athlete.

Participants will leave feeling accomplished physically and encouraged spiritually. In addition to hands-on instruction, athletes will hear a motivational message designed to inspire confidence, character, and purpose. Our goal is not only to help them grow in their basketball abilities, but to remind them that they are more than their sport or their talent—they are called to use their gifts to serve others and make an impact. To further connect the experience, every clinic participant will receive complimentary ticket to the evening Light Up The City concert, tying together a powerful weekend of growth, faith, and community.

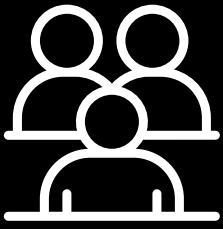
ABOUT ME

Though raised in the church, Anthony's journey has not been without struggle. During his college years and early in his professional career, he found himself drifting due to the temptations, pressures, and influences around him. 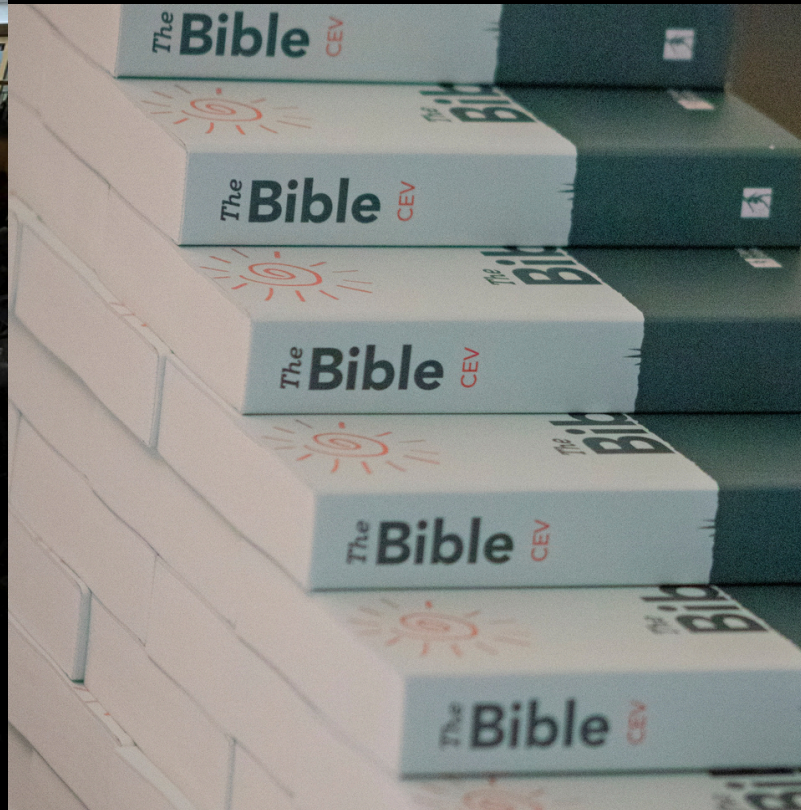




THE IMPACT OF LIGHT UP THE CITY

Flexible Event Partnership Options

1. Ticket-Based Model

2. Free Admission / Honorarium-Based Model

Admission can be free to maximize outreach. A designated offering may then be received to support the continued missionary expansion of Light Up The City across Canada and beyond.
